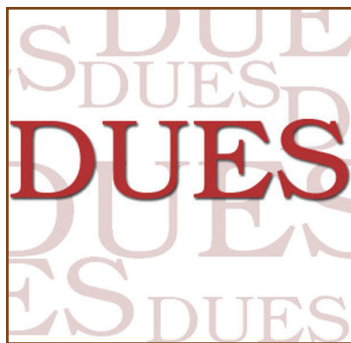

the potential cost savings involved and in case some did not see this article. In brief, Waste Management (WM) will honor price comparisons if the individual homeowner calls WM and provides price comparison information. Specifically, RAD (Right Away Dis-

posal) is providing garbage collection once a week (on Fridays) for \$10.00 per month, and garbage and recycle collection for \$14.00 per month. WM should then lower your future bills to that level. I have talked to a number of residents since the September article and they indicated to me that WM has indeed lowered their rate. Others have simply waited till their 3 month bill period was over with and canceled with them and gone over to RAD. This is your choice.

For your information: I did contact WM as President of the Home Owners Association to see if I could get



this lower price comparison rate for all our residents and they indicated that they could not do this: each resident has to call in themselves. ... I also just contacted RAD to see if they could do anything more for us if we have a specific number of residents using their service. The manager I spoke to said he would review this and get back to me. When I find out his response, I will contact people via an e-mail blast or at the Annual Meeting. He did indicate their rates are very low now, and did not know if he could go lower, but will review and get back to me.

Nextdoor RANCHO DEL CERRO

There are a number of people in our neighborhood who are now getting daily information from a site called Nextdoor RANCHO DEL CERRO. This site has items such as lost or found animals, requests and responses on contractors of all types, etc. Once you sign up and provide your e-mail address, the messages come in automatically, and there are often 3 to 6 messages daily.
