
ANNUAL MEETING AND POTLUCK

I am also meeting this week with an accounting firm to see if they can handle the accounting end of things for the HOA. Of course if we go to this alternative, it will cost the HOA some money for those services.

SO IF YOU WANT AN HOA, some of you have to step up and help! I am looking to fill the following positions: Treasurer, Architectual Control, and Secretary.

• The Secretarial position is just sending out the quarterly minutes of the Board Meetings, and the Annual Meeting - which is easy, because I prepare talking points before each meeting. • The Architectual Control position is only when somebody requests approval of a job outside their house and, occasionally, reviewing the streets for repair notices to the County.

• The Treasurer's job is more involved and does take a few hours per month for the first few months of the year, and then there is not too much to do. Much of this is automated.

As of March 18th, while writing this newsletter, 82 of the 111 resi-

dents have paid their dues. That means that 29 homeowners have not paid, even though an e-mail reminder was sent out the first week of March. The

bills for our \$25.00 annual dues were sent out on January 15th, and were due by Feburary 15th. A reminder e-mail was sent out on March 1st and and 14 have paid, but there are still 29 outstanding. We need this money to help fund our expenses.


